Council Chairman Linda W. Cropp announces a public roundtable by the Committee of the Whole on Bill 16-585, the "Closing of Public Alleys in Square 743N, S.O. 04-12457, Act of 2006." The public roundtable is scheduled for Friday, January 27, at 10:30 am, in Room 412 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW.

Bill 16-585, introduced by Councilmember Jack Evans, would close two 8-foot-wide, east-west alleys in Square 743N, which is bounded by L Street SE, M Street SE, New Jersey Avenue SE, and 1st Street SE, in Ward 6. The applicant for the alley closings is Faison, which requests the closing to facilitate development of a mixed use project consisting of two130-foot-high buildings: (1) a 226,000 square foot, 240-unit residential building at the corner of 1st and L Streets SE; and 2) a 263,000 square foot office building with ground floor retail fronting 1st and M Streets SE.
